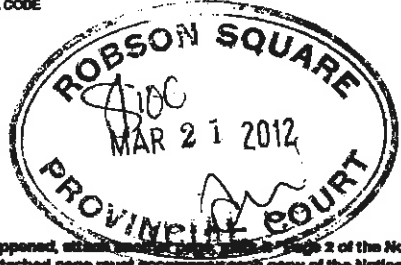

At this point, Thu Watson called Christopher Wilson and informed him that she was in the middle of a lawsuit causing her assets and bank accounts to be frozen. As a result, she had been unable to pay Christopher Wilson the remaining \$2000. She assured Christopher Wilson that she would pay the owed amount by mid-January. Christopher Wilson has not heard from her since after repeated phone calls and text messages.
